Three GD-463D10 monitors will be in each of the two Telegenic production trucks used for this live Sky 3D broadcast. In each vehicle, one 3D monitor will be used on the transmission live cut, one for the preview, and the third will be split into quads to show the four most-used cameras. Telegenic may also use the JVC IF-2D3D1 3D image processor for certain feeds if required.

The match will take place at MEN Arena and will be available in the homes of Sky 3D television or Sky World HD subscribers and in specialist pubs across the country.

As David Haye himself claimed in the run up to the fight; "I can assure everybody that watches the fight in 3D that, at some point during the fight, Audley Harrison will land on your lap in a crumpled heap."
